

Fig. 2 shows the opinion of Pupil Teachers about Soft Skills Education Programme with respect to Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS)





Fig.3 shows the opinion of Pupil Teachers about Soft Skills Education Programme with respect to Employability Skills



CONCLUSIONS

- 54.12% of the Pupil Teachers strongly agreed that Soft Skill Education Programme was extremely helpful in sharpening their Communication Skills.
