- 1. 96% students were satisfied with Academic Aspects delivered through online as well offline platforms used by colleges. 96% students agreed that their course content was completed on time and their doubts were also addressed by teachers. 93% students were happy to get equal opportunity to participate and got adequate study material in online and offline classes.
- 2. 95% students appreciated the apps and tools being used by the teacher educators to disseminate information and content clarity. ICT Skills of 93% students improved their professional skills.
- 3. 94% students were satisfied with internal evaluation process as it helps to monitor their progress. Moreover, 85% students find fairness in the process of internal evaluation.
- 4. 89% students expressed that the co-curricular activities organized by college were sufficient for their emotional development, but they missed peer group interaction. 95 % students learnt self-discipline during classes. Moreover, 93% students considered physical classroom teacher-student interaction better than online interaction.
- 5. 94% students felt that their teaching skills were developed during Internship Programme. 95% students learnt skills to organize co-curricular activities, evaluation techniques and use of teaching strategies during internship programme. 97% students realized that college helped to develop their communication and employability skills.
- 6. 93% students perceived easy availability of teachers while 7% students held opposite opinion. 92% students noticed the contribution of colleges to readdress their all grievances. 86% students accepted that relevant course books were easily available and accessible in library. 96 % students had good experience to be BCMites
